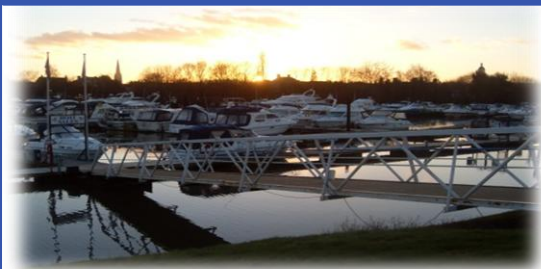

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS

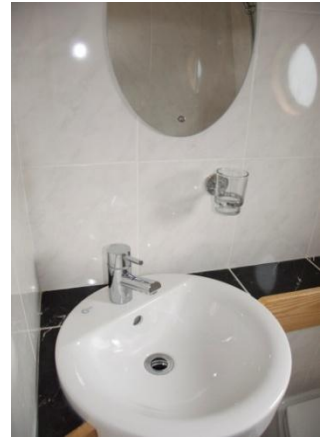
Accommodation for the course will be provided on 'North Star' – a 60 foot narrowboat which was added to Starline Narrowboats' fleet in 2010. The interior of the boat is fitted out beautifully and provides comfortable living space for your stay. The weekend will provide you with an authentic narrowboating experience and whilst you may not know your fellow guests at the start of the course, we hope you will have made some firm friends by the end of it!

"NORTH STAR"

'North Star' was added to the Starline Narrowboats fleet in 2010.

The boat was designed with flexibility of layout in mind, and as such it provides accommodation in 3 cabins – 1 Double and 2 Double or Twin. The cabins are divided by doors to ensure privacy at night. There are two 'wetroom' style bathrooms on board, each one shared by two cabins (including hosting team)

The ash interior, along with two side hatches, ensure the interior remains light and airy at all times.



Each cabin has windows, private storage and a divider to provide privacy overnight. The two bathrooms are shared (1 between two cabins) with each cabin having adjacent access to a bathroom. The saloon / dinette is at the front of the boat, seats 8 people and all meals will be served in this area.
